



School-Age Dyslexia Checklist

If you answer yes to more than five of these questions, you may show signs consistent with dyslexia.

Need for time to produce an oral response when questioned		
Difficulty remembering sequential information, e.g. times tables, science procedures, historical facts		
Poor concept of time

Word finding difficulties		
Difficulty with fluent, accurate reading affecting comprehension		
Difficulty with/avoids reading aloud in class		
Difficulty with phonological awareness especially at phonemic level		
Persistent difficulty with spelling		
Poor structure and organization of written work		
Difficulty copying from the board		
Difficulties producing clear, legible handwriting		
Takes longer than average to complete written tasks		
Low self-esteem		
Aggressive or non-compliant behaviour		
Work avoidance tactics
